

Welcome to KidPower 2016

What is KidPower?

KidPower is a half-day (with optional after-care) summer enrichment program that works to empower children in grades K-8. KidPower fuses exciting art and leadership curriculum to create a fun and engaging approach to overall positive youth development and leadership skills building. Our goal is to provide a fun summer full of field trips, art classes, swimming, performances, urban farming, and more.

Who participates?

Everyone is encouraged to apply. In keeping with our mission we strive to serve the residents of South Minneapolis. Importance is placed on creating quality summer opportunities for all students regardless of means.

How much does it cost?

KidPower is free for kids who qualify for free and reduced lunch. Otherwise, the fee is \$50.00/week. We will work with you to make KidPower accessible for your family!

We go on field trips!

KidPower often takes the classroom outdoors, exploring our city and all of the wonderful art opportunities around town. Parents are always encouraged to join us! Please let us know if you need to pick up your child early, it's quite possible they'll be out and about in the neighborhood.

What about lunch?

Free lunch is provided by the city of Minneapolis and the Boys and Girls Club of Phelps Park. Lunch is served at Phelps from 12:00-12:30. All KidPower students are invited to join us.

Do I have to be there all summer?

Yes! We understand people travel a lot in the summer, but we need to know in advance. Please call us if you know your child will be absent so we don't worry. Space is limited, so if your child is absent for over two consecutive days you may lose your spot to the next student on the waiting list.

What about Summer School?

Summer school is important for your child. We will work with you and neighboring schools to arrange bussing to UAA if possible. We will be happy to meet your student at the bus and be sure they get a healthy lunch.

Pick up is at 4:30pm sharp.

Please be on time. Our staff is able to supervise an unstructured after-care from 4:30-5:30. All students must be picked up by 5:30pm.

Parent Involvement:

We would like to invite parents to join us 4 times during the summer to participate in art and leadership projects with their students at the end of the day. We also invite parents to join us for all field trips throughout the summer.

My children are eligible for free and reduced lunches. I will provide a letter of proof.

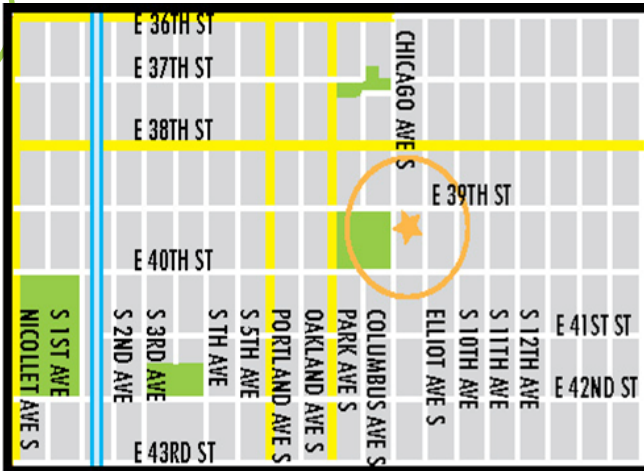
I will make a \$50/week payment for KidPower.
