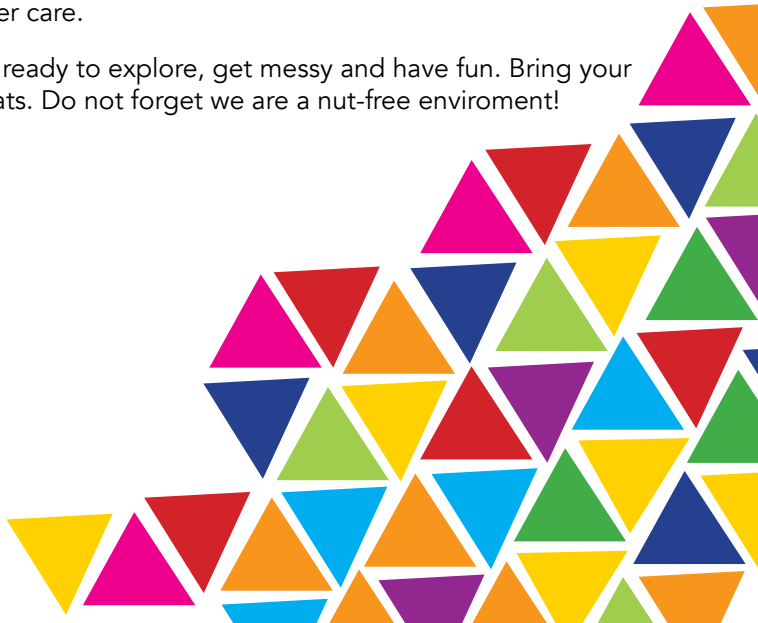

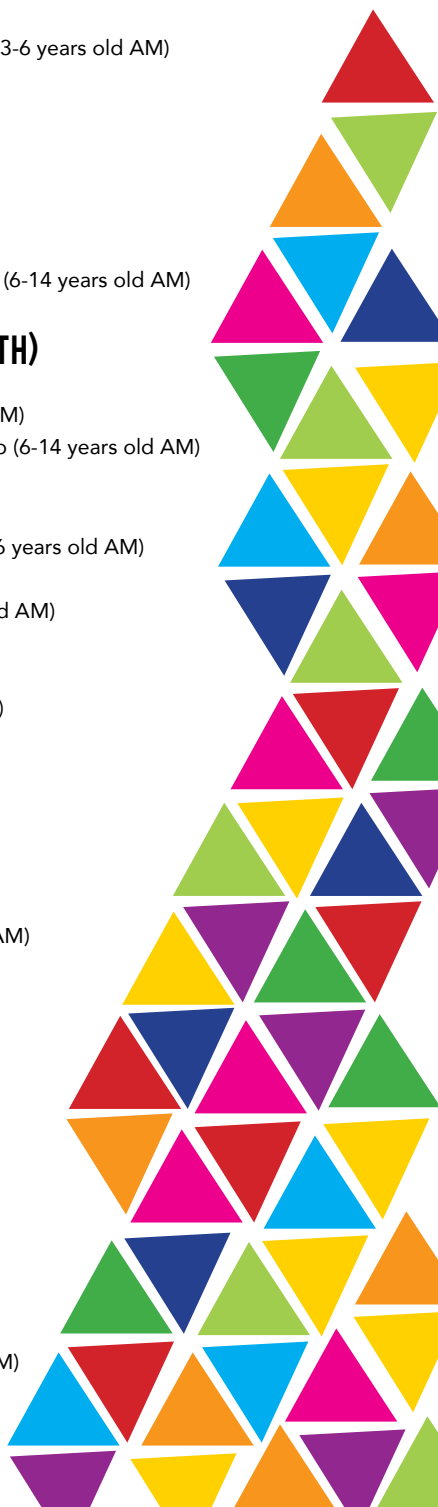

WEEK 1 JUNE 19-22

AM Dragons and Wizards and Castles, Oh My!

Dive into magical realms with Urban Arts! Travel back in time to a magical kingdom of make-believe. In this camp, we'll create our dragons, magical potions and cloaks, and let our imaginations run wild.

PM Backyard Bonanza

Explore the wonder in our own backyard. Come make nature prints, use magnifying glasses to explore the crazy world of insects, learn about birdcalls and the amazing plants growing in our city and so much more!

WEEK 2 JUNE 26-29

AM Messy Monet Madness

All the ways to paint that you don't get to do at home! We'll splatter paint, blow bubbles to paint, paint with our feet and more. We'll then turn some of our abstract awesomeness into individual and group projects by layering, dissecting and reconstructing. Remember to wear clothes and shoes that can get dirty, we'll get messy!

PM Dream Forts

Who doesn't love their own special hide-away? We'll make forts of different sizes for different beings – do the insects by your house need a fort? Using cardboard, blankets, duct tape and decorations we'll create a big fort for all to use for reading stories, playing games – anything we can imagine! We'll also create our own miniature abodes. This camp is all about imagining, designing, and building our ideal forts.

WEEK 3 JULY 3, 5, 6, AND 7 (CLOSED JULY 4TH)

AM All Things Puppet

Come get silly with us as we create all sorts of puppet friends. Find out how many fingers you can puppeteer at once, how light and shadow can create

puppets on a wall and how to make puppets dance using string. We'll have fun sharing stories and playing games with the very puppets you create.

PM Minnesota Woodsy Wildlife

Do you know how many types of mammals live in our home state? What is Minnesota's largest fish? Join us as we learn all about the amazing animals of Minnesota. We'll read stories, become bears, make loon calls, and find adventures both in the classroom and outside our doors.

WEEK 4 JULY 10-13

AM Rhythm and Spice... and All Things Nice

In this music camp, we'll explore rhythm through song, dance and visual art. Come make instruments, learn new songs to perform with friends and help us create our own UAA band! We'll also use sound and music to paint and create.

PM Across the Universe

Come explore space right here at Urban Arts. We'll make galaxies with glow-in-the-dark paint, create our own 3-D rocket ships, and see if we can find signs of alien life in our own neighborhood...? Have you ever wanted to explore your inner astronaut? This is the camp for you.



WEEKLY SUMMER CAMPS (AGES 3-6)

WEEK 5 JULY 17-20

AM Young Builders Sculpture

This camp is all about sculptures! Come ready to explore clay, paper-mache, recycled materials, and wood. We'll create animals, abstract art, shape-art and much more.

PM Deep Sea Diver

The ocean is a magical, mysterious place. There are creatures that live so deep down, they have to make their own light! Get ready to explore the deep ocean through games and art-making. We'll paint, draw, build and play.

WEEK 6 JULY 24-27

AM Move It, Move It

Are you a foot-tapper, chair-boogier, breakdancer or ballerina? Do you love to get down and twirl high? This is the camp for you! We'll move our bodies all week in different ways to a variety of music. Come shake it with Urban Arts!

PM Shake it and Bake It

This is the camp where you get to play with your food. We'll cook up yummy dishes and snacks. We'll also make art projects out of edible items like bread sculptures and potato stamps.

WEEK 7 JULY 31-AUGUST 3

AM The Wacky Scientist

Make gloppy goo and volcanoes that explode! Mix moondust and quicksand for sinking toys! Explore gravity, dye fabrics and more in this fun camp where art meets wacky science.

PM Kingdom of Clay

In this camp you will create your own kingdom out of clay: castles, figurines, bowls and accessories. Most importantly...you will get to create all of your kingdom's rules! We'll use a combination of air-dry and kiln-fired clay (fired in our own UAA kiln!).

WEEK 8 AUGUST 7-10

AM Dinosaur Dig

Calling all young archeologists! This camp is all about dinosaurs – come create and learn about these giant, mysterious creatures! We'll paint dinosaurs, sculpt dinosaurs, have an archeological dig and put dinosaur bones together.

PM Stories and Books Camp

Do you have stories to tell? Come take a journey into your imagination in this camp. We will illustrate our own books, create group stories and even make a giant class book!

WEEK 9 AUGUST 14-17

AM Little Hands Mosaic Camp

Did you know there are many ways to create mosaics? Beautiful things happen when we put many small pieces together to create a whole. Come explore, design, and create!

PM The Me-seum Museum

In this camp we'll explore different styles of art throughout the week, culminating in our own art museum exhibit, curated by our campers themselves. At the Me-seum Museum, you will get to tell your own story with each art piece you create!
