In case of an emergency, I understand my student will be transported to an appropriate medical facility by the local emergency unit for treatment if the local emergency resources deem necessary.

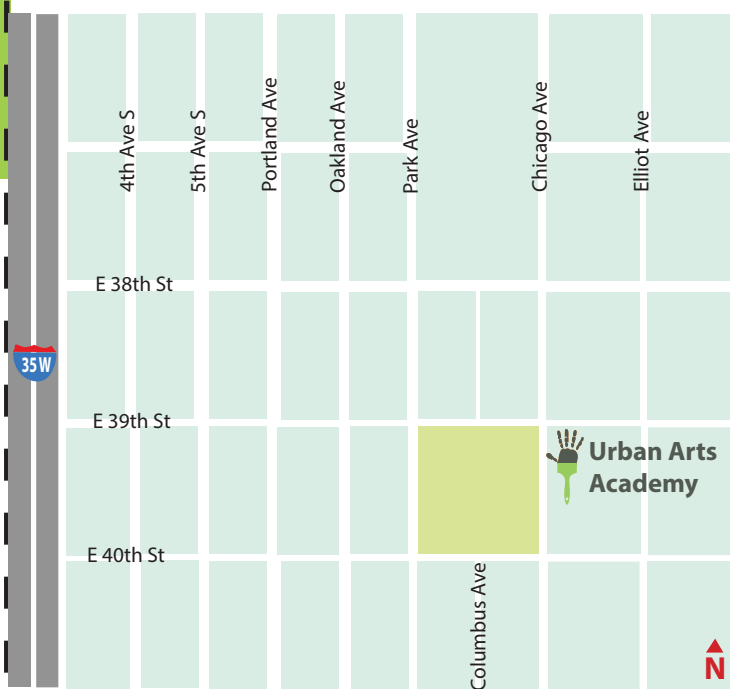

LEADERSHIP OUTCOMES

In 2015-2016, funding from Youthprise allowed UAA to engage high school youth in leadership development training and planning revolving around the design of a new program for themselves and their peers. The pilot the students designed included three elements:

- Art
- Leadership
- Entrepreneurship

Students worked with Project Footsteps on leadership development and were mentored by different artists in various mediums. They learned about entrepreneurship and ways they could turn their art into a business. The students decided to meet twice a month for 3-4 hours on the weekends.

Students are paid \$25 for each session they attend.
